The **Minutes of March** meeting were reviewed by the Board. Wahls motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Cummings seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

The **Executive Minutes for March** were reviewed by the Board. Shaffer motioned to approve, Settles seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion Carried.

The **Unpaid Bills for April** were reviewed by the Board. Settles motioned to approve the unpaid bills for June, Cummings seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

Water- Shaffer

- Shaffer wrote letters to Windmill company that is located outside of Waynesville to see if money might be granted to help in cost replacing meters with updated technology.
- There are six more fire hydrants that need to be flushed, Wahls will get a hold of the Fire Department regarding this.
- High Water Usage was reviewed

Sewer – Brown

- Discussed Trummel’s sewer that is under their deck. They are replacing the deck with a lid that will be able to get to the tank. Leach field is too low, maybe able to build it up verses putting a whole new one in. Will continue discussion with Randy at next meeting.

Streets & Alleys – Lowery

- Phil Koberlein attended the meeting to go over upcoming projects for Street and Alleys. Also discussed the amounts and funds we can use from Motor Fuel Tax fund, such as Randy’s backhoe time and pay that could be reimbursed to the General Account.. We will need to adopt a resolution to cover the costs for projects and to appropriate the money for the fiscal year of May 1, 2026 to April 30, 2027. Wahls motioned to adopt the resolution to use money for projects that were present and proposed to the Village Board. Cummings seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.
- Wahls inquired if we were able to sell surplus equipment that we did not need or use, in order to purchase equipment that is needed. Will continue discussion at the next meeting when Randy is at the meeting.
- Board discussed no longer selling rock or millings. Wahls motioned to stop selling rock and millings, Bristow seconded. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

Finance-Bristow & Cummings

- Tim will have John Hoblit check on the Annual appropriations, goes along with the budget.
- Finance committee will be meeting to discuss budget.

Miscellaneous

- Village is having First Arbor Day on April 26th, 2026 from 2-4. AB Hatchery donated 2 trees that will be placed at Gingerbread Park by corner of playground equipment. Cookies, water, and activities for kids.
