The **Minutes of April** meeting were reviewed by the Board. Wahls motioned to approve the minutes as presented. Cummings seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

The **Unpaid Bills for May** were reviewed by the Board. Bristow motioned to approve the unpaid bills for May, Settles seconded the motion. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

The **Balance Sheet for April** was reviewed by the board. Bristow motioned to approve and Wahls seconded. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

The **Profit & Loss Statement** was reviewed by the board. Shaffer motioned to approve and Cummings seconded. Roll Call: Aye all. Motion carried.

**Ordinances- Health & Safety – Settles**

- Janice Dellinger needs the Village to vacate the alley at 305 10<sup>th</sup> Street in order to sell property. Wahls motioned to approve ordinance to vacate the alley, Settles seconded. Tim will contact lawyer, John Hoblit to have the ordinance approved and set up.
- A resident moving into the village had questions regarding chickens and the ordinance regarding them. Tim told him we are currently working on the ordinance. We need to modify the ordinance. Tabled to discuss the ordinance to the June meeting and approve modifications.
- Discussed addresses in town that need to be town down and possibly condemned. Will talk to John Hoblit to find out how to do this.

### **Water- Shaffer**

- High Water Usage was reviewed.
- Randy is flushing hydrants. Water plant program that runs filter is running well. Back flow preventer is working properly. CCR is done and will be on back of water bills.

### **Sewer – Brown**

- Letters regarding increase that will start in May and reflect on June's bill will be mailed out once John has the amendment for the water ordinance completed.
- Letter being sent to address with home that has fence on the septic tank, to be moved due to it obstructing working or pumping the sewer properly.
- Randy will start annual sewer inspections.
- Randy indicated there was a line going to the creek on the west side of property that was plugged from the mound. He was able to mow this time and broke it loose (unplugged) it with the auger.

### **Streets & Alleys – Wahls**

- Randy's Tree service gave Randy F. quotes for 12 trees to be removed. Wahl's will look at the trees and decide which ones need to be removed.
- Wahl's will update at June meeting the projects that they will be starting.

### **Finance-Bristow & Cummings**

- Finance committee will be meeting to work on appropriations ordinance and build the budget off the appropriations. Will also have a monthly budget. There will be another committee meeting before June meeting to present the budget at the next meeting.

### **Miscellaneous**

- Town Clean-up Day for the Village of Waynesville and the Waynesville Township will be on June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2026, 8 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Waynesville Township is going in half with us on the dumpsters. We will have 4 dumpsters.
